Rules for Vehicles Operating on the Beach

For the Purpose of Sport Fishing 2018-2019

The City of North Wildwood in accordance with the municipal code (Chapter 138 Section 6) permits vehicles to be operated on the beach during the period from **September 4, 2018 - May 20, 2019** for the purpose of sport fishing only.

REGULATIONS

On the Inlet Beach: from New York Avenue to the intersection of John F. Kennedy Beach Drive & 2nd Avenue.
From the day after Labor Day until the Monday before the Monday on which Memorial Day is observed,
from 4:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m.

On the Front Beach: from the intersection of John F. Kennedy Beach Drive and 2nd Avenue to 26th Avenue
From October 1st until April 30th, from 4:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m.

On the Front Beach: from the intersection of John F. Kennedy Beach Drive and 2nd Avenue to 26th Avenue.
From the day after Labor Day until September 30th, and from May 1st until the Monday before the Monday on which
Memorial Day is observed, from 4:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m. and from 6:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m.

USE APPROPRIATE BEACH ENTRANCE DURING HOURS THAT THE ADJACENT BEACH IS OPEN
2nd & Ocean Avenues, 8th & JFK or 15th & Beach Entrance

Vehicles must cross over the dunes at the specific vehicle crossovers located at 8th, 15th and 22nd Avenues
Use of a pedestrian crossover by a vehicle is strictly prohibited

The applicant must present the vehicle that the permit will be issued on at the North Wildwood Police Department for inspection. The applicant must then complete an application and submit the appropriate fee. The vehicle must contain certain items before use on the beach. Upon meeting this requirement a permit sticker will be issued.

RULES

Permit fee: \$20.00

Required equipment: tow rope, jack with board, inflated spare tire, shovel, fire extinguisher with the necessary material and supplies, first aid kit and flashlight.

Prohibited vehicles: no vehicles with eating or sleeping accommodations shall be issued a permit or to be operated on the beaches at any time.

Vehicle Requirements: the vehicle must be properly registered and bear a current inspection sticker issued by the state the vehicle is registered in.

Speed limits: the speed limit for vehicles operated on the beach is 15 mph.

Points of access to the beach: Access to and from the beach shall be made at 2nd, 8th, and 15th Avenues.

Areas of operation: except during actual entrance and exit from the beach no vehicle shall be operated at a distance of 50 feet from the then existing high tide line and no closer than 50 feet to any sand dune.
In addition, while entering and exiting the beach, care shall be taken not to operate across or cause damage to any sand dune.
